




Youth Advocacy Committee (YAC)

- Community health







Nicotine Use in Marin

Data from the CA Healthy Kids Survey


11th Grade Vaping Rates Higher in Marin than California Average






The Tobacco Retail Environment



Tobacco Retailer Density

- retailer density: the number of businesses that sell tobacco within a specific geographic region
- more tobacco retailers =
 - increased youth exposure to targeted advertisements and promotions
 - increased youth exposure to tobacco-use behavior
 - more accessible tobacco products
 - increased smoking rates in adults and youth (NIH)



Tobacco Retailer Density

• regulating tobacco retailer density in CA:

municipalities regulate tobacco retailer density in some capacity

jurisdictions restrict the proximity of tobacco retail sales venues' locations to youth-populated areas





Ross: A Tobacco-Free Town

Ross: Today

- Current protections:
 - o smoke-free public spaces
 - o smoke-free multi-unit housing
 - tobacco retail license (TRL) required to sell tobacco
- As of now, there are <u>zero</u> tobacco retailers within Ross
 - However, there is no policy preventing a prospective retailer from selling in Ross





Protecting Future Generations: Our Proposal

Proposed Policy Details

- Keep Ross a tobacco-free community!
 - Prevent tobacco retailers from entering Ross
 - Amend Ross Ordinance No. 699 (outlines rules around smoking/tobacco) to formally prohibit the sale of tobacco in Ross
- This has already been done in Beverly Hills and Manhattan Beach
 - 22 jurisdictions in CA have banned ecigarettes



Policy Benefits

- **Protects** future residents, particularly youth, from the harms of tobacco
- Promotes a healthy community
- Raises awareness about the harms of tobacco and nicotine while encouraging current users to reduce their use
- **Sets** a positive example for neighboring communities



Take Action Now!

Amend Ross Ordinance No. 699 to formally end the sale of tobacco in Ross.
