 4. **Town Council to decide if it wants to adopt Resolution No. 2648:** 
 - **Approving a Professional Services Agreement with Gensler, Inc. for Facilities Master Plan Amendment Services in an amount not to exceed \$286,879;**
 - **Establishing a Facilities Master Plan Amendment Project with a total project budget of \$320,000;**
 - **Appropriating \$320,000 from the undesignated Operating Fund balance in the Fiscal Year 2026-27 budget for implementation of the Project; and**
 - **Authorizing the Town Manager to execute the Professional Services Agreement with Gensler Inc. (Johnson)**

5. Town Council to consider adopting Resolution No. 2647: 
 - (1) acknowledging the proponent's timely withdrawal of the Friends of Ross Firehouse Initiative (Initiative) under Elections Code section 9215.5; and
 - (2) rescinding Resolution No. 2609, which ordered the Initiative submitted to the voters and requested consolidation with the November 3, 2026, election and requesting the Marin County Board of Supervisors and County Elections Official to remove the measure from the November 3, 2026, consolidated ballot. 6. Town Council to consider approval of the argument language in support of the Ross Valley Paramedic Authority (RVPA) parcel tax renewal measure to be submitted to the County of Marin Elections Office for the November 3, 2026, General Municipal Election, and decide who should sign the argument on behalf of Councilmembers (i.e., Mayor, all five Councilmembers, or a portion thereof). 7. Adjournment.
